Preface

Dear Data Subject, the "European Regulation 2016/679 concerning the protection of individuals with regard to the Processing of Personal Data, as well as the free movement of such data", provides for the protection of persons and other subjects regarding the processing of personal data.

ISTITUT CULTURAL LADIN, as "Data Controller", pursuant to article 13 of Reg. EU 2016/679, wishes to illustrate the purposes and methods by which your personal data are collected and processed.

In particular, we provide you with the following information:

3. Purposes of processing and legal basis:

Your personal data will be processed exclusively for the purposes connected to the procedure for access to the "internet service" made available by the "Padre Frumenzio Ghetta" Library, of the Ladin Cultural Institute/Istituto Culturale Ladin.

The conferment of data is optional, but essential to provide the aforementioned service and therefore failure to provide data would prevent the controller from carrying out the aforementioned purpose.

a) Execution of a task of public interest or related to the exercise of public authority to which the data controller is invested (Article 6 para. 1 l. e) GDPR)

The legal basis that makes the processing of personal data mentioned above legitimate is to be found in the pursuit of the institutional tasks entrusted to the LADIN CULTURAL INSTITUTE/ISTITUT CULTURAL LADIN, and more precisely it must be identified in the enhancement and protection of the linguistic minority to which it is entrusted.

4. Data processing procedures

In relation to the stated purpose, the processing of personal data is done using manual, or computer technology with logic strictly related to the purposes and, anyway, so as to ensure the security and confidentiality of data in accordance with the law mentioned in the epigraph.

The existence of automated decision-making processes, including the so-called profiling.

5. Third parties categories to which Personal Data may be communicated

Your data will be processed exclusively by the internal personnel of the Body authorised and instructed on the methods and limits of the processing. Likewise, they may be processed by third parties who perform activities that are instrumental for the Data Controller as external Data Processors pursuant to art. 28 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679. The data will not be disclosed, except in case of advertising required by law and that in any case will not concern particular data.



6. Processing duration and data retention period

We inform you that the retention period of your personal data, as provided for in the "maximum margin", is unlimited. However, the data will be deleted upon your specific request, without prejudice to the data controller's right to keep them for purposes compatible with those indicated above, or for statistical purposes.

7. Data transfer outside the European Union

The collected data will not be transferred to non- European countries.

8. Rights of the data subject

In your capacity as a data subject you can assert the rights referred to in Articles 15 and following of Reg. EU 2016/679 below Rights of access, rectification, integration and deletion of data, portability, limitation of processing and withdrawal of consent given.

- a) According to Reg. (EU) 2016/679, you have the right to request access to your data from the data controller, as well as the correction, integration or cancellation thereof. Within 30 days from the submission of the request, you will receive feedback in writing also by electronic means.
- b) You also have the right to oppose the processing or to request the limitation of the same, for legitimate reasons and in the cases provided for in Articles 18 and 21, Reg. EU 2016/679.
- c) You may withdraw your consent to the processing of data provided for the purposes set out in this statement at any time.
- d) Finally, you can exercise the right to data portability, requiring the data controller to transmit them to another controller.

To exercise the rights indicated above, it will be sufficient to use one of the Data Protection Officer's addresses indicated in point 2.

Right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority.

You have the right to contact the Supervisory Authority by submitting a complaint, where you consider your data to be processed illegitimately and contrary to the relevant legislative provisions.
